Providence provided him with such an opportunity when he became president, and the act creating the U.S. Interstate Highway System became law on June 29, 1956.

As part of the 50th anniversary celebration of the highway system, a coast-to-coast "reenactment" of the 1919 caravan was scheduled, this time with only 20 vehicles. The course was to be reversed, beginning in San Francisco on June 16 and ending in Washington, D.C. on June 29, 2006. One of the last stops on the journey? The Toms Creek Bridge on South Seton Ave. in

Emmitsburg. This overpass was one of the first crossed on the 1919 journey.

The bridge was repaired in preparation for the commemorative caravan. It is ironic that in 1863 Union and Confederate forces traversed Toms Creek; and in 1919 a future U.S. president passed over it on a journey that years later would lead to construction of an Interstate Highway System. President Eisenhower, who had a farm in Gettysburg, crossed that bridge many times, including the day in 1957 when he attended SJC convocation ceremonies. ■

From Rome we travel by bus to Livorno, stopping in Assisi for a tour and lunch. During a two-day stay in Livorno we will visit historic sites of significance to Elizabeth Seton, including Montenero and St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Parish. From Livorno, we proceed to Pisa for tours and lunch, and then go on to Florence. After three days of art, dining and shopping, we fly to Paris, visit the Chapel of The Miraculous Medal at Rue du Bac and en-

joy two days of sightseeing, shopping and cuisine before flying home.

Hotel accommodations are double occupancy and located within walking distance of main areas of cities. Estimated cost of the trip is between \$3,000 and \$3,500, which includes flights, bus transportation, hotels, five group dinners and continental breakfasts. The price may change, so please factor in a 20 percent +/- variance.
